#### I. The Evidence of the Empty Tomb

The empty tomb did not prove that Jesus was alive, but it is the foundation of that belief. The preaching of the 1<sup>st</sup> century centered in the resurrected Lord. It depended on that tomb being empty. The opponents of Christianity would have simply produced the body.

### II. The Appearances of Jesus

The Point of I John 1:3 is that the disciples were certain Jesus who was dead was alive again.
