The Church at Antioch

Acts 11: 25-26

Text: Peter's experience with Cornelius opened the door to include Gentiles.

• There is no room for prejudice against any Christian in the church.

I. The Dissolving of Racial and Religious Prejudice. (v. 1-18)

The church leaders did not believe the Gentiles were included in the loving purpose of God.

The gift of the Holy Spirit to Cornelius changed everything.

II. The Purpose of God Includes the Gentiles! (v. 19-24)

III. Christian Conduct Results from Christian Teaching! (v. 25-26)

First called Christians in Antioch

Conversion produces Christian conduct and character.

Why was the name given?

What was involved in being a Christian?

(Jews, Gentiles, Samaritans, Male and Female, Salve and Free, Housebroken or not)

IV. The Practice of Generosity. (v.27-30)

We must be generous in our Christian Compassion.

Not a command but real compassion.

Conclusion:

Everyone is included in the Loving Purpose of God!

Do we possess this truth in our attitudes, actions, and ambitions?
