

While they were raising money for that land, it looked like they were going be \$20,000 short. A wealthy benefactor came through at the last minute with a check for the remaining amount due. Imagine the surprise of everyone when the check bounced! Joy was turned to sadness. Then, the District Governor "loaned" the camp the remaining funds - in effect, the government lowered the price of the land so the Lions could establish a camp that has blessed thousands of children.

You wake up from a dream and it may pop into your head. This one tiny idea is not developed or calculated, but for some reason it's been deposited on the inside of you. This is what it can seem like when God is encouraging you to move in a certain direction. One thought can lead to places we've never imagined. Great things can be created by one person, one need, one problem, one issue. Don't dismiss these thoughts. Don't brush off something that seems small. Don't obsess about changing the world, start by changing one person. Maybe that's yourself. Maybe it's taking better care of your health so you can spend quality time playing with your children. Maybe it's helping a single parent who is overwhelmed by watching her children for the day or cleaning her house. Maybe it's volunteering in your community or helping out once a week a local soup kitchen or nursing home. Use what moves you, what God has put inside of your heart, and take one step forward."
