-We are not His children but children of wrath.

-There is no such thing as the universal fatherhood of God.

-We are like lost sheep.

-We are dead in our trespasses and sin.

Christ came into the world to deliver us from our sins.

**CHRIST IS THE ONLY ONE WHO WILL INTRODUCE US TO God!**

Christ's sacrifice was final.

Galatians tried to add to salvation.

ILL. Prodigal son. Elder brother would not come

to the party

Let's accept grace and not become judgmental!

\*\*\*\*\*\* Christ died once and for all FOR SINS

iLL. Pre-washed car

Sin interrupts our relationship with God.

I Cor. 15:3 "Christ died for our sins, according to Scripture"

Gal. 1:4 "Christ gave Himself for our sins."

I John 2:2 "Propitiation for our sins."

Mystery- can't explain

**CHRIST SUFFERED AND DIED FOR SIN!** 

HOW CAN WE VALUE IT !??

**\*\*\*\*\*\*\*Christ died once and for all for our sins.** 

The just for the unjust

ILL. Mike "I knew you wouldn't let me sleep alone!"

Mystery – He who deserved no suffering bore that suffering. Christ died For us who deserved to suffer.

Christ's death was neither by accident nor by the will of men, but by the will of God.

Only forgiveness without reason can match sin without excuse.

<u>\*\*\*\*\*\*Christ died once and for all for all sin, the just for the</u> <u>unjust to bring us to God.</u>

The whole object of sacrifice – to restore that lost relationship.
