**Without exception the entire revelation of God says:**

**-We are not His children but children of wrath.**

**-There is no such thing as the universal fatherhood of God.**

**-We are like lost sheep.**

**-We are dead in our trespasses and sin.**

**Christ came into the world to deliver us from our sins.**

**CHRIST IS THE ONLY ONE WHO WILL INTRODUCE US TO God!**

**\*\*\*\*\* Christ died once and for all.**

**Christ's sacrifice was final.**

**Galatians tried to add to salvation.**

**ILL. Prodigal son. Elder brother would not come  
to the party**

**Let's accept grace and not become judgmental!**

**\*\*\*\*\* Christ died once and for all FOR SINS**

**iLL. Pre-washed car**

**Sin interrupts our relationship with God.**

**I Cor. 15:3 “Christ died for our sins, according to Scripture”**

**Gal. 1:4 “Christ gave Himself for our sins.”**

**I John 2:2 “Propitiation for our sins.”**

**Mystery- can't explain**

**CHRIST SUFFERED AND DIED FOR SIN!**

**HOW CAN WE VALUE IT!??**

**\*\*\*\*\*Christ died once and for all for our sins.**

**The just for the unjust**

**ILL. Mike “I knew you wouldn't let me sleep alone!”**

**Mystery – He who deserved no suffering bore that suffering.  
Christ died For us who deserved to suffer.**

**Christ's death was neither by accident nor by the will of men,  
but by the will of God.**

**Only forgiveness without reason can match sin without  
excuse.**

**\*\*\*\*\*Christ died once and for all for all sin, the just for the  
unjust to bring us to God.**

**The whole object of sacrifice – to restore that lost  
relationship.**
