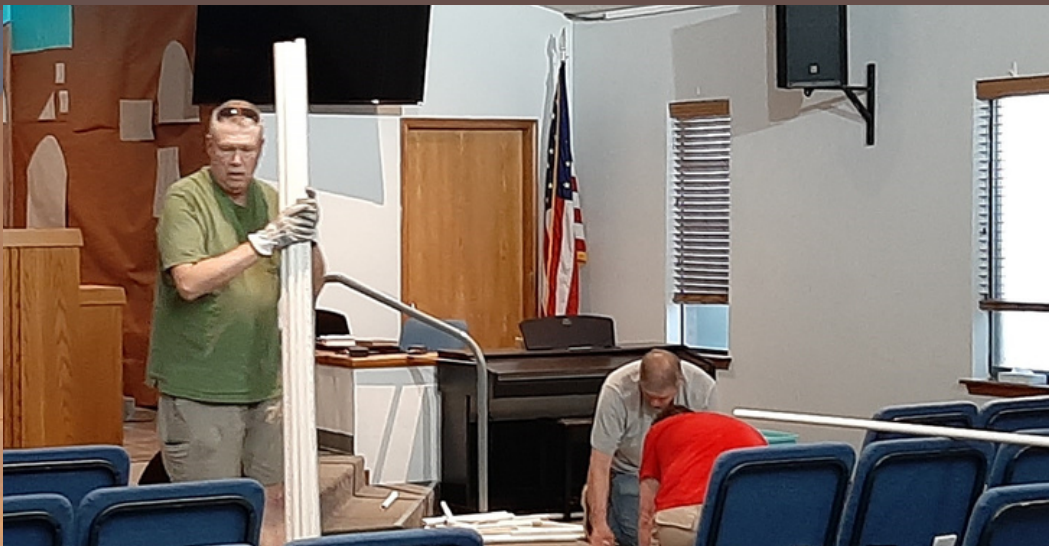
Dedicated and faithful - took on the deeply unpleasant task of cleaning out the sheds.

Above is a picture of the portion of the ceiling depicting Jonah, who is seated on a throne with a large fish by his side.

Michelangelo painted the ceiling of the Sistine Chapel from 1508-1512. Around the center of the ceiling are twelve figures that represent the coming of Christ. Seven of these figures are prophets and five are the female sibyls\* of the classical world. The pagan sibyls were included to symbolize that the Messiah was to come for all the people of the world and not just the Jews. These twelve figures are the largest on the vault of the chapel. In order, they are: Jonah, Jeremiah, Persian Sibyl, Ezekiel, Erythraean Sibyl, Joel, Zechariah, Delphic Sibyl, Isaiah, Cumaean Sibyl, Daniel, Libyan Sibyl.

### **Jonah reminds us that grace is for everyone!**
